



Maria Chiara Carrozza is an Italian Scientist and Member of the National Parliament, Chamber of Deputies, Foreign and European Affairs Committee.

From 2007 to 2013 she served as Rector of Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna.

In 2013, she was elected Member of the Italian Parliament.

From April 28, 2013 until February 2014 she served as Italian Minister for Education and Research.

She currently coordinates the NeuroRobotics Area in The Biorobotics Institute at Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna.

Since 2016 she is President of the Italian National Group of Bioengineering.

Since 2017 she is member of the Italian Task Force in Artificial Intelligence of AGID (Italian Digital Agency)

In 2016/17 she has been Chair of the Panel for the interim Evaluation of FET Flagships Program for the European Commission, DG Communication Networks, Content and Technology. She is member of the High Level Steering Committee of the FET Flagship in Quantum Technologies.

She is Partner of the IUVO, a start-up in wearable robotics founded in 2015 as a spin off of The Biorobotics Institute.

Since 2015 she serves in the Board of Directors of the Piaggio Spa group.
